Value Education:

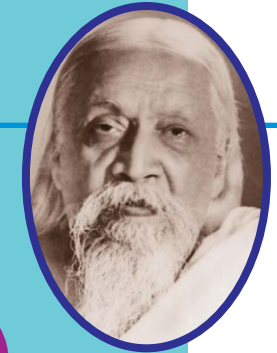

Syllabus :

Curriculum:

10+2 pattern of education is followed in the school. Jnanadeepa provides general education of 10 years leading to AISSE (All India Secondary School Examination). Provision is also made to continue education in Science and Commerce stream at plus two level leading to AISSCE (All India Senior School Certificate Examination)

Evaluation :

Evaluation is an integral part of the total teaching / learning process and testing will be made comprehensive so as to include the all-round growth of the learner in both scholastic and co-scholastic areas. Tests will be used for diagnostic and remedial teaching. Independent study and class assignments help in promoting self learning and developing confidence. Home Assignments will be minimal.

There is no formal test/exam for students of classes I to V. Their performance will be continuously assessed by means of oral response, worksheets, involvement and response in classes and related activities.
